Ski Resorts

Snowmobiling

Snowmobiling is available at both Tangram Ski Circus and Madarao Ski Resort. For beginners, Tangram Ski Circus has a Yamaha Licence Acquisition course to obtain a snowmobile license, after which you are free to join a long forest course tour.

Cross-country Skiing

Kurohime and Mt. Myoko, and a course that gently meanders through quiet forests, just to name two. Rental services and changing rooms are of course available for your convenience.

Winter Activities



Snowshoeing and Nature Skiing

Step into a unique, snow-covered world, either on snowshoes or skis. Some of these forest areas are only accessible in the winter, when deep snow covers the low lying bush and scrub, leaving only towering trees, with the only signs of life being animal footsteps dotted around the beautiful white carpet. The best way to enjoy this wonderland is with an experienced guide, who has intricate

knowledge of the terrain, and plant and animal life, as well as the best vantage points along the way, and will craft a makeshift table out of the snow on which the group will be served lunch.

Smelt Fishing

A trip isn't complete without a unique experience like this!

Sake Brewery Tours

Founded in 1875, Takahashi-Sukesaku Shuzoten is the oldest sake brewery in Shinanomachi. Blessed with clean local spring water and rice, the brewery has been able to pass down its traditional skills and techniques through the generations. Uga Shrine

Biwa Island, also known as Benten Island, is host to Uga Shrine, which is believed to have been established in 730. Reach the island by canoe or pleasure cruise, pay a visit to the shrine, then wander around the mysterious island!

Bass Fishing

Lake Nojiri is renowned in Japan for its great smallmouth bass fishing. Why not drop a line and enjoy the beautiful surroundings while waiting for the strong strike of the bass!

Windsurfing

The relatively small ripples on Lake Nojiri, compared with waves in an ocean, make it an ideal place for beginners to try their hand at windsurfing. There are a range of the latest boards and sails available, making it possible to pick up the basics in around half an hour.

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Walking and Trekking

There are numerous walking routes in and around Shinanomachi, as well as the surrounding national park areas, including Lake Nojiri, and Kurohime, Madarao and Togakushi Highlands, where the beauty of nature can be enjoyed on foot from spring to autumn. Shinanomachi is also the home town of Kobayashi Issa, a renowned Haiku poet from the early 19th century. Issa's former residence, as well as the remnants of an Edo era post station, can be taken in on one of the many walking courses on offer, which range from one hour to a full day.



Mountain Climbing

Mt. Madarao, at a height of 1,382 meters, takes roughly one to two hours to hike, and is ideal for beginners. From the top of Mt. Daimyojin-dake, which is close to Mt. Madarao, hikers are blessed with a splendid panoramic view of Lake Nojiri, surrounded by the 'Hokushingogaku', five revered local mountains that dominate the landscape, and the majestic Northern Japan Alps in the background. Mt. Kurohime, one of the 'Hokushingogaku' and a well-renowned moutain in Japan, is situated in a National Park, and is notable for its differing varieties of trees you encounter as you climb up the mountain. It takes roughly eight hours for a return hike of Mt. Kurohime, meaning adequate preparation, equipment, experience and ability are required. Mountain guides are of course available. Please contact the Shinanomachi Tourist Information Center for details.

Fishing Ponds


